

About Pierson Park

Pierson Park is a 6.2 acre site located east of Central Avenue between Pickett Road and Gwin Road. Pierson Park includes two playgrounds including a climbing rock, a large turf area, a gazebo with a group BBQ, three horseshoe pits, two bocce ball courts, a community garden, restrooms and parking.

The McKinleyville Library is located in Pierson Park and maintained by the District and operated by the County. In 2010, the McKinleyville Library was expanded to include a 720 square foot conference room equipped with Wi-Fi.

The conference room is available to rent by the public.

Azalea Hall is also located in Pierson Park. It is a 6,820 square foot Community Center. Overlooking Pierson Park, Azalea Hall includes a 2,000 square foot Hewitt Room, which features natural wood-beamed ceilings, adjustable lighting, a stage and sound system, projector screen, and a fully equipped commercial kitchen. It seats up to 200 persons for banquets and 300 in assembly. Azalea Hall also features a Meeting Room, which is an ideal place for small, quiet group meetings. It has a seating capacity of 50 persons for banquets and 75 in assembly. It is situated within our Senior Room, and is generally available after 4:00 pm weekdays and also on the weekends.

The McKinleyville Activity Center is a gymnasium located in Pierson Park. The facility is 10,000 square feet, featuring a full-size gymnasium, bleachers, a spacious lobby, a sound system, and a variety of indoor sporting equipment (including roller skates). This facility is ideal for sporting events, birthday parties, gatherings and larger special events and fundraisers.

The Law Enforcement Facility is located adjacent to the library in Pierson Park. It is owned by the District and operated by the Humboldt County Sheriff's Department.
